Headphone adapter with wireless remote control is capable of using iPod's 3.5-mm stereo headphone mini-jack to control volume and tracks. It works seamlessly with VoiceOver features on iPod shuffle 3G and nano 5G. What you need to do to activate the VoiceOver feature on compatible iPods, you just press remote control's "Play/Pause" button. It allows you to hear artist, track and playlist information without taking your eyes away from what you're doing.

The feature of wireless infrared remote control is not only music control and video playback including play/pause, next/previous and volume but also handling phone calls on your iPhone. This solution allows users to have more fun and fully enjoy your Home/Car Audio, Home theater and PC speaker like never before.



	Next track	Single click
	Previous track	Single click
	Volume up	Single click or long press
	Volume down	Single click or long press
	To hear your current song name	Click and hold the button
	Change playlist	Click and hold the button and release after you hear a tone. When you hear the playlist you desire, click to select it.








LED Indicator

The indicator light will be turned on when it is attached to the USB port. After the audio cable is connected to the headphone jack, the LED will flash when you press any one of the remote buttons. It indicates proper operation.



Auto volume adjustment (for iPod shuffle 3G only)

Step 1
Plug in the audio jack to shuffle.
* You will hear 4 beeps.



Step 2
Re-plug in again then you will hear the "beep..." getting louder and it will take about 10 sec. to activate the auto volume adjustment process and automatically adjust the volume output level at 80%.



* It will play at the same volume as was last set. If you hear the tune is low, please try to use the remote control to adjust your desired volume level or follow the "Step 2".

VoiceOver

The iPod shuffle 3rd generation and iPod nano 5th generation's exciting new feature of VoiceOver is not only let you browse and navigate your music but tell you the title or artist of a song without taking your eyes away from what you're doing.

Audio control is supported by

- iPod nano 5th generation (requires software ver. 1.0.3)
- iPod classic 120GB/160GB (requires software ver. 2.0.1)
- iPod touch 2nd generation (requires software ver. 2.2 or later)
- iPhone 3GS/4
- iPad
- Mac (released after Oct 2008)

It will work with iPod nano 4, iPhone and iPhone 3G, but with limited functionality. The control of iPhone's Volume up and down feature will not work on these products but it will not influence the speaker volume control.

Audio control and VoiceOver are supported only by

- iPod shuffle 3rd generation
- iPod nano 5th generation
