Driver Installation

For Windows® 2000&XP/Vista

Windows® 2000, XP and Vista follow IEEE 1284 specification to support standard driver bundled in Windows. After plug in the Parallel 1-Port Express Card, Windows® 2000, XP and Vista will automatically detect the adapter and will install the needed driver.

To Verify Windows® 2000/XP/Vista Installation

1. Right click **My Computer**, and then click **Manage**. Click **Device Manager**.
2. Click on the + (plus sign) in front of **Universal Serial Bus controllers**, one **USB Printing Support** should be displayed.
